

How to Apply for Adult Developmental Services and Supports in Ontario

Find out if you are eligible

To find out if you can apply for services and supports funded by Ontario's Ministry of Community and Social Services, you will need to provide Developmental Services Ontario with documents that show:

1

- you have a developmental disability
- you are 18 years of age or older
- you live in Ontario

Developmental Services Ontario staff can tell you more about which documents you will need for this. They will then review this information to see if you are eligible to apply.

Fill out an application and discuss services and supports

2

If you are eligible, Developmental Services Ontario staff will discuss your needs and goals with you. They will also help you fill out an application.

They will talk with you about the services and supports that may help you participate in community life.

Create a support plan

3

Developmental Services Ontario staff will then create a support plan with you. This plan will list services and supports that could be available to you.

Find out if services and supports are available

4

Based on current resources and your needs, Developmental Services Ontario staff will contact you to let you know if services and supports funded by the ministry are available.

If these are not available for you right away, staff will follow up with you when they become available. They may also be able to tell you about other programs in the community that are not part of services and supports funded by the ministry.

5

Connect with services and supports

If services and supports are available for you, Developmental Services Ontario staff will connect you to them.
